THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF CORBIN, KENTUCKY, MET IN SPECIAL SESSION ON SEPTEMBER 18, 2013, AT THE CITY GOVERNMENT CENTER, WITH THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS PRESENT:

**PAY ADJUSTMENT** – MOTION BY HODGE, SECOND BY TYE, VOTE OF ALL MEMBERS PRESENT BEING YEA, THAT THE BOARD APPROVE A PAY ADJUSTMENT IN THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT OF \$.01 PER HOUR FOR THOSE EMPLOYEES CURRENTLY MAKING \$8.74 PER HOUR. IN JULY WHEN THE PAY ADJUSTMENTS WERE MADE, THEY WERE INCREASED FROM \$8.24 TO \$8.74 PER HOUR. NEW HIRES ARE CURRENTLY MAKING \$8.75 PER HOUR. THIS ADJUSTMENT WILL BRING THESE EMPLOYEES IN LINE WITH THE CURRENT PAY SCALE. AN ADJUSTMENT WILL BE MADE BACK TO JULY 1, 2013.

**LONDON/CORBIN AIRPORT GRANT** – MOTION BY SHELTON, SECOND BY RAZMUS, VOTE OF ALL MEMBERS PRESENT BEING YEA, THAT THE MAYOR BE AUTHORIZED TO SIGN A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$7434.00 ON BEHALF OF THE LONDON/CORBIN AIRPORT FOR SURVEY WORK. THIS GRANT IS FOR THE AIRPORT IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM.

**TAX REFUND** – MOTION BY TYE, SECOND BY SHELTON, VOTE OF ALL MEMBERS PRESENT BEING YEA, THAT THE BOARD APPROVE A 2012 TAX REFUND TO TED HEDRICK IN THE AMOUNT OF \$99.96. HE WAS ELIGIBLE FOR THE HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION.
